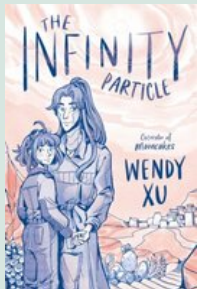

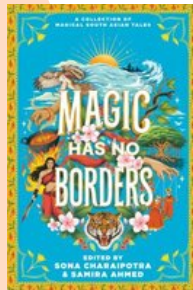


The Half-Life of Love by Brianna Bourne

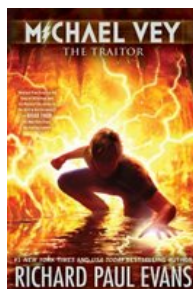
