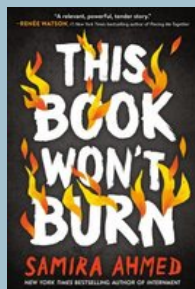


Six Truths and a Lie by Ream Shukairy

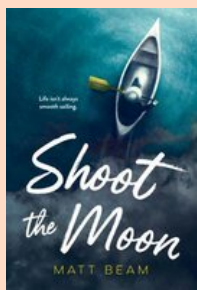
The Dark We Know by Wen-Yi Lee

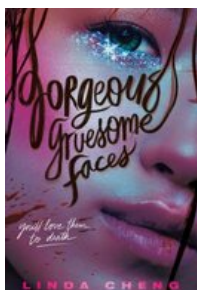
Only She Came Back by Margot Harrison

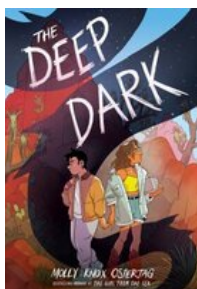
Gorgeous Gruesome Faces by Linda Cheng
